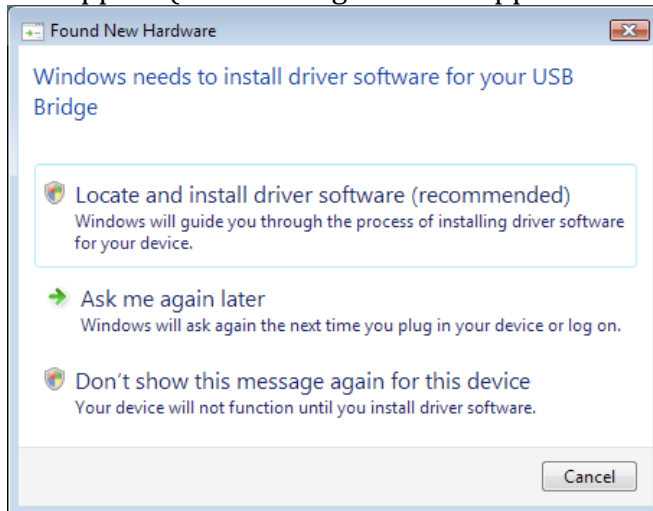


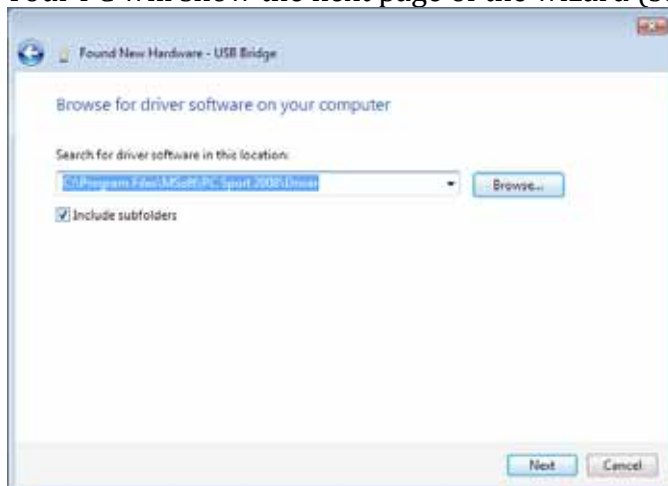
Installing VDO Series-Z Docking Station USB Driver on Windows Vista

1. Plug the Docking Station into an USB Port. The „Found new Hardware Wizard“ will appear (if this dialog does not appear see Appendix C):



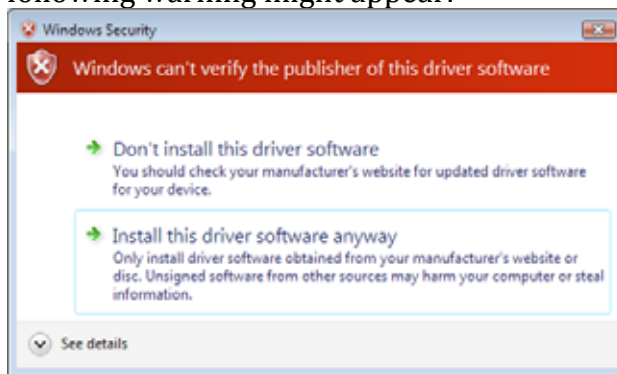
Select “Locate and install driver software”.

2. Select „Don't search online“.
3. Select “I don't have the disc. Show me other options”.
4. Select “Browse my computer for driver software”.
5. Your PC will show the next page of the wizard (see Figure below):



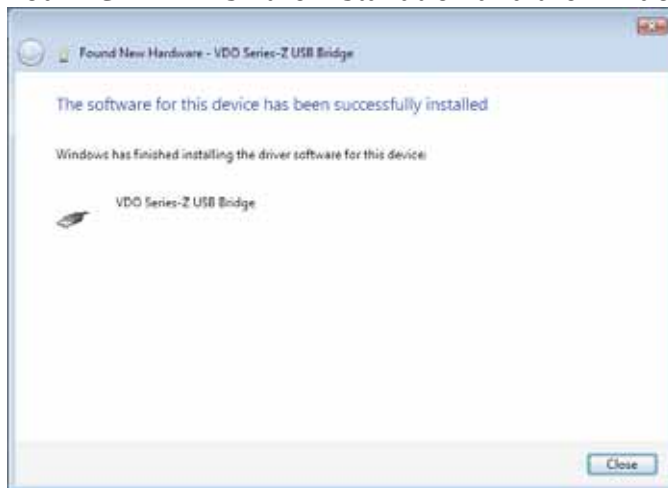
Click „Browse“ and select the file „pcsbridge.inf“ or “vdobridge.inf” (depending on installed software version) from your PC Sport\Driver directory (Default: c:\Program Files\MSoft\PC Sport 2008\Driver). Click „Next“.

6. Your PC will now automatically install the driver. During the installation the following warning might appear:



Choose „Install this driver software anyway“.

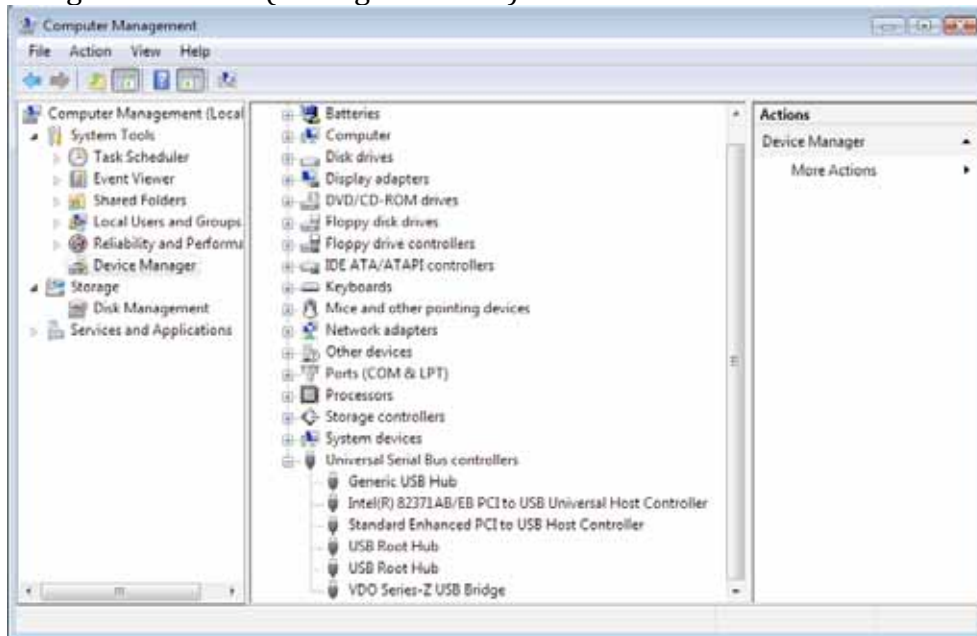
7. Your PC will finish the installation and the window below will appear:



8. Click „Close“ to complete the installation

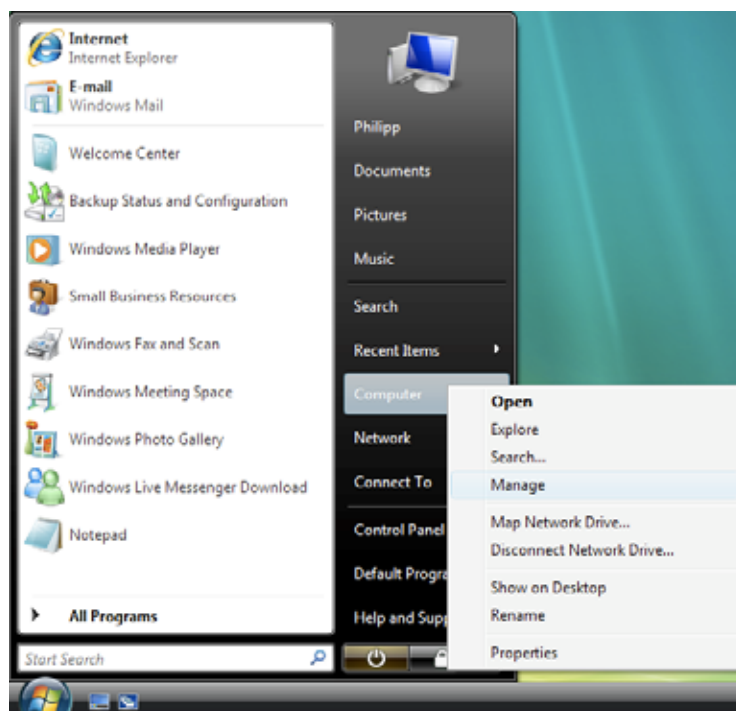
Appendix A: Ensure that the installation finished without errors

1. Open the device manager (see Appendix B)
2. Expand „Universal Serial Bus Controller“
3. If the installation completed without errors you will see „VDO Series-Z USB Bridge“ in the tree (see Figure below):



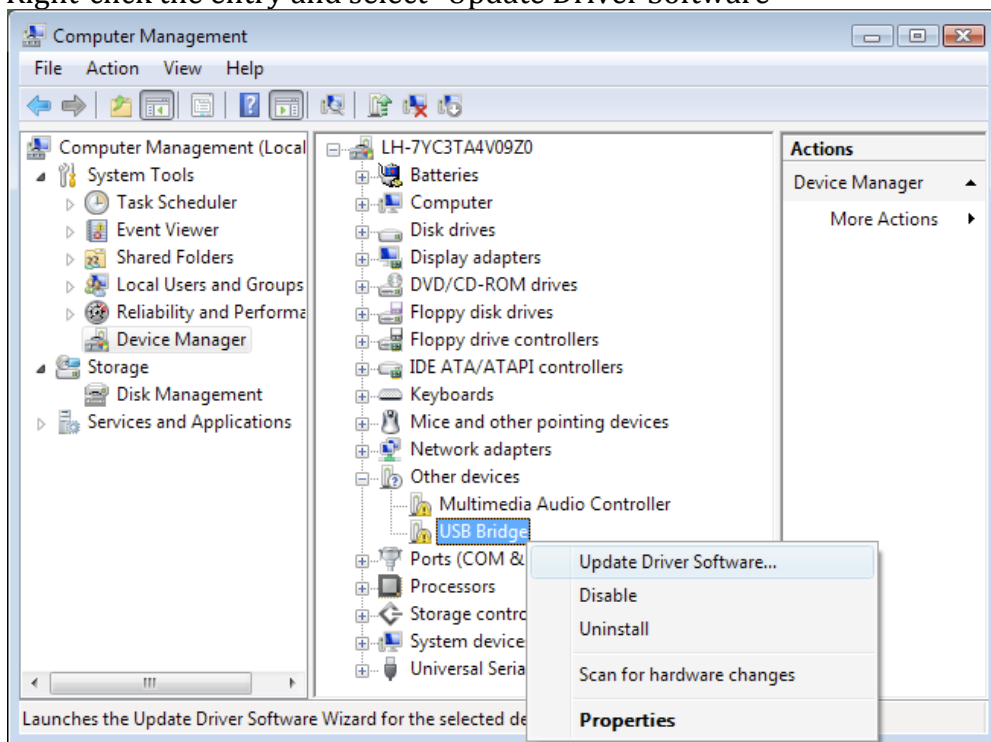
Appendix B: Opening the device manager

1. Right-click „Computer“, click „Manage“, and then select „Device Manager“.



Appendix C: Starting driver installation manually

1. Open the device manager (see Appendix B)
2. Locate the entry “USB Bridge”, normally in the section „Universal Serial Bus Controller“
3. Right-click the entry and select “Update Driver Software”
